

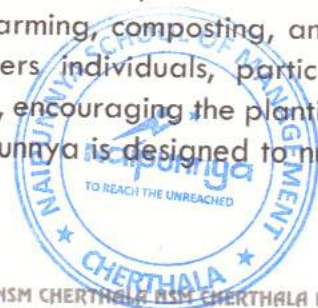
## GREEN GEN ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION INITIATIVE
