The Annual Report for the Academic Year 2024-25

The Annual Report for the Academic Year 2024-25 presents an overview of the significant achievements, activities, and developments of the Postgraduate (PG) Department of English at our institution.

Department Overview - Established in 2004, the PG Department of English initially offered a Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) in English and Communicative English. In 2012, the department expanded its academic offerings with the introduction of the Master of Arts (M.A.) program in English Language and Literature. Currently, the department provides two courses:

- **Undergraduate Level:** B.A. English and Communicative English
- **Postgraduate Level:** M.A. English Language and Literature

Student Enrollment and Faculty - In the academic year 2024-25, the department has a total enrollment of 24 students, comprising 14 undergraduate students and 10 postgraduate students. The department is supported by a dedicated team of 13 faculty members, which includes instructors in Hindi and Malayalam. Among the faculty, one member holds the National Eligibility Test (NET) qualification, while another possesses the State Eligibility Test (SET) qualification.

Academic Performance - The department has demonstrated commendable academic performance. The undergraduate (UG) program achieved a pass percentage of 62% for the 2022 batch, with 5 out of 8 students successfully clearing their examinations. The postgraduate (PG) program of 2023 admission had 10 students in the department, and their results are awaited.
