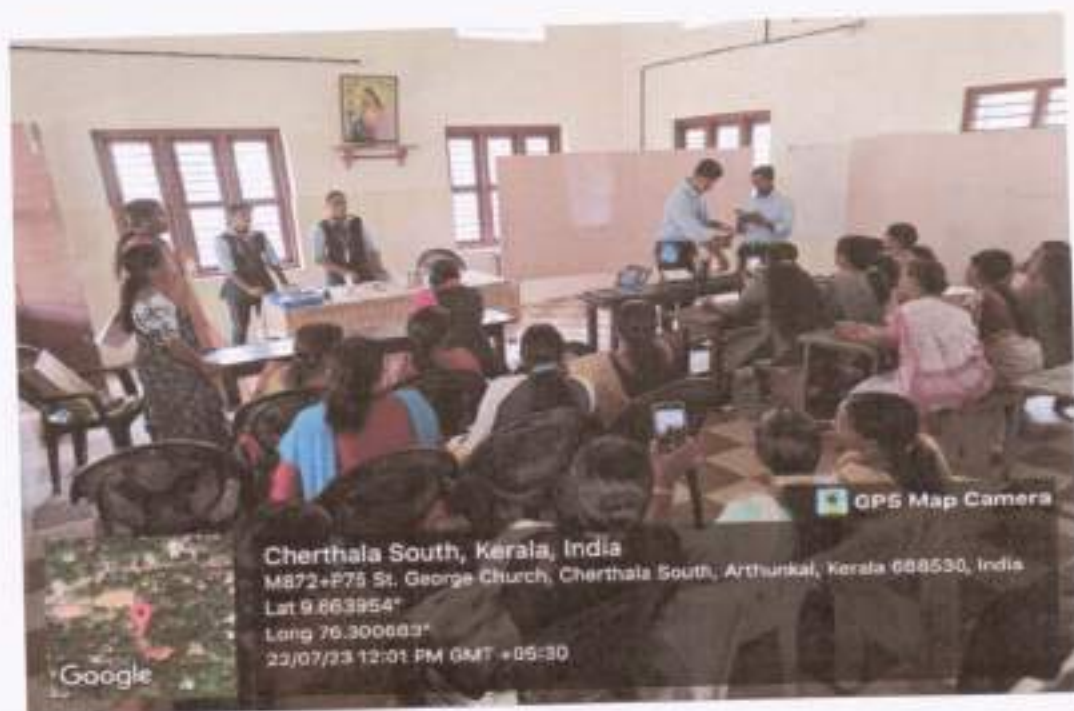


Figure 4 Health Drink demo by HM Students

On February 24th, 2023, Naipunnya School of Management organized a beach cleaning activity called "Clean Arthunkal" as part of its initiative, "Samudra," aimed at uplifting coastal communities.

The event took place at Arthunkal Beach, Alappuzha, from 8:00 am to 9:30 am. The initiative was executed by the National Service Scheme (NSS) volunteers of the college. The primary objective of this activity was to contribute towards the betterment of coastal communities by cleaning up the beach. The event commenced promptly at 8:00 am with the enthusiastic participation of approximately 45 NSS volunteers. Equipped with gloves, garbage bags, and a strong sense of community service, the volunteers embarked on their mission to rid the beach of plastic and other waste materials. The volunteers diligently collected waste materials, focusing primarily on plastic waste, which poses significant threat to marine life and ecosystems. They sorted the collected waste into two categories: degradable and non-degradable. The segregation ensured that recyclable materials were separated from those that could decompose naturally.

This meticulous sorting process was crucial for effective waste management. Once sorted, the waste was deposited in designated areas approved by the Village Panchayat. Summary report

As part of college best practice 'SAMUDRA' a workshop on paper bag making was conducted on October 30, 2023, at 10 am at the Logos Centre, St. George Church, Arthunkal, in collaboration with the ED CLUB of Naipunnya School of Management, Cherthala. The event witnessed the active participation of 26 members from various Kudumbashree units in the Arthunkal region. The primary aim of the program was to instil entrepreneurial skills among the beneficiaries. The workshop was organized and led by students of the ED CLUB who had received training in paper bag making. The workshop was designed to be hands-on, providing participants with practical experience in the art of paper bag making. The event commenced promptly at 10 am, with a prayer lead by the kudumbashree members followed by welcome speech by Mr. Tomy Elesseril, Panchayat member, Arthunkal. Then the 'SAMUDRA' coordinator Ms. Saranyamol VR introduced the programme with the participants and also shared the program's objectives and the significance of promoting entrepreneurship within the community. Ms Swapna VI, coordinator representative of ED Club coordinated the training session. ED CLUB students, Ms Binduja Rajesh from S5 BBA and Ms Nandana Lalji from S5 BBA who had become proficient in the craft of paper bag making, took on the role of instructors, sharing their knowledge and skills with the eager participants.

The basic objective of the workshop was to empower and nurture entrepreneurial skills among the Kudumbashree members. The program aimed to equip them with the knowledge and abilities needed to start their paper bag making ventures, thereby generating a sustainable source of income. The participants were introduced to the techniques of designing, cutting, and folding paper to create high-quality, ecofriendly paper bags. Through practical exercises and demonstrations, they gained insights into the production process, materials, and quality control. The workshop witnessed enthusiastic participation, with 26 members from various Kudumbashree units in the Arthunkal region. Kudumbashree is a poverty eradication and women empowerment program implemented by the State Poverty Eradication Mission of the Government of Kerala. The participants were drawn from different units, bringing together a diverse group of individuals eager to explore entrepreneurial opportunities.

The SAMUDRA workshop on paper bag making was a resounding success. Participants left with a newfound sense of purpose and the skills necessary to embark on their entrepreneurial journey. The workshop evoked tremendous enthusiasm, as evidenced by the overwhelmingly positive feedback received from the beneficiaries. Many expressed their excitement at the prospect of developing this opportunity into a small-scale industrial unit, which they believed would provide a much-needed source of income for themselves and their families. The programme ended with vote of thanks delivered by Annie Eliso, exam cell Naipunnya school of management Cherthala at 12.45 pm.

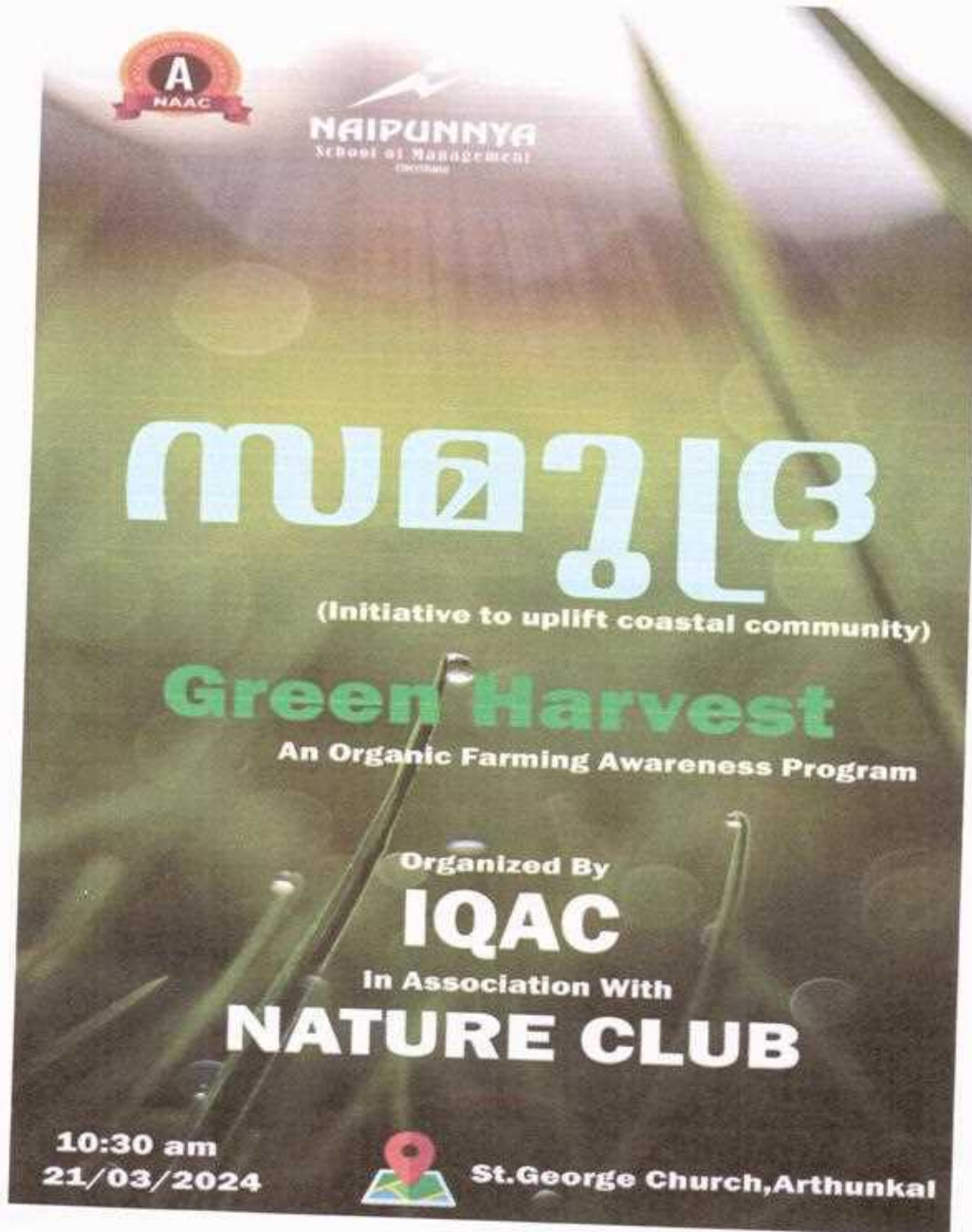

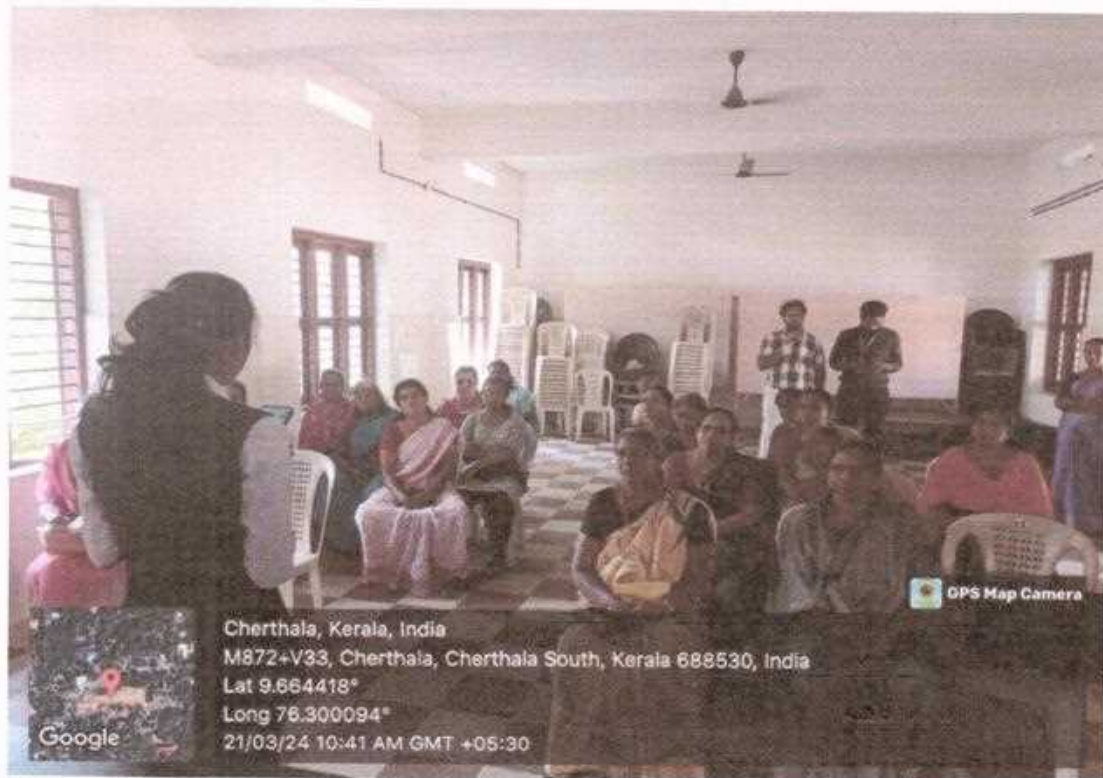
